## CARDBOARD ITEMS



Cardboard dumpster

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Envelope Boxes
- Cereal Boxes
- Pop Cartons
- Tissue Boxes
- Posterboard

Attention: Please flatten all cardboard before discarding...it saves space.

## NEWSPAPER ITEMS



Newspaper container

- Daily Nebraskan, NYT, Journal Star, etc... Ad inserts are okay.
- Magazines and Catalogs

## PRINT CARTRIDGES

- Laser Print and Ink Jet Cartridges: Place old cartridge in the replacement cartridge box, write "Recycle" on outside of box, and send with outgoing mail.

- Call the UNL Recycle Office if you are cleaning out your office and want to have a tote delivered to you for temporary use.

## UNACCEPTABLE OFFICE PAPER ITEMS:

Paper Clips and Binder Clamps



Folders with metal parts (ex. hanging folders)



Plastic and Metal Bindings



Directories, Magazines, Catalogs, and Journals



Food and Candy Wrappers



Paper Towels and Tissue Paper

- Cardboard with food waste
- Cardboard with oil
- Wax coated cardboard
- Styrofoam
